Metro District Virtual Information Meeting

Due to the impacts of the Coronavirus pandemic, the three informational metro district town hall meetings that were scheduled during April have been combined into one virtual meeting at 6 p.m. Thursday, April 30.

If there is still interest after the virtual meeting, another in-person meeting will be scheduled when we are able to conduct public gatherings again.

There are several ways to participate in the meeting, which will feature a presentation by the Special District Association of Colorado and city staff and time to ask questions. The meeting will take place using video conferencing.
